4. **Matters arising:**
  - a) **Police meetings:** Feedback from meeting, 1<sup>st</sup> April: There is a central government drive towards more community policing; we should expect to see some increase in policing at street level; there will be more spot checks for speeding, not wearing seat belts, illegal tyres and the illegal use of mobile phones.
